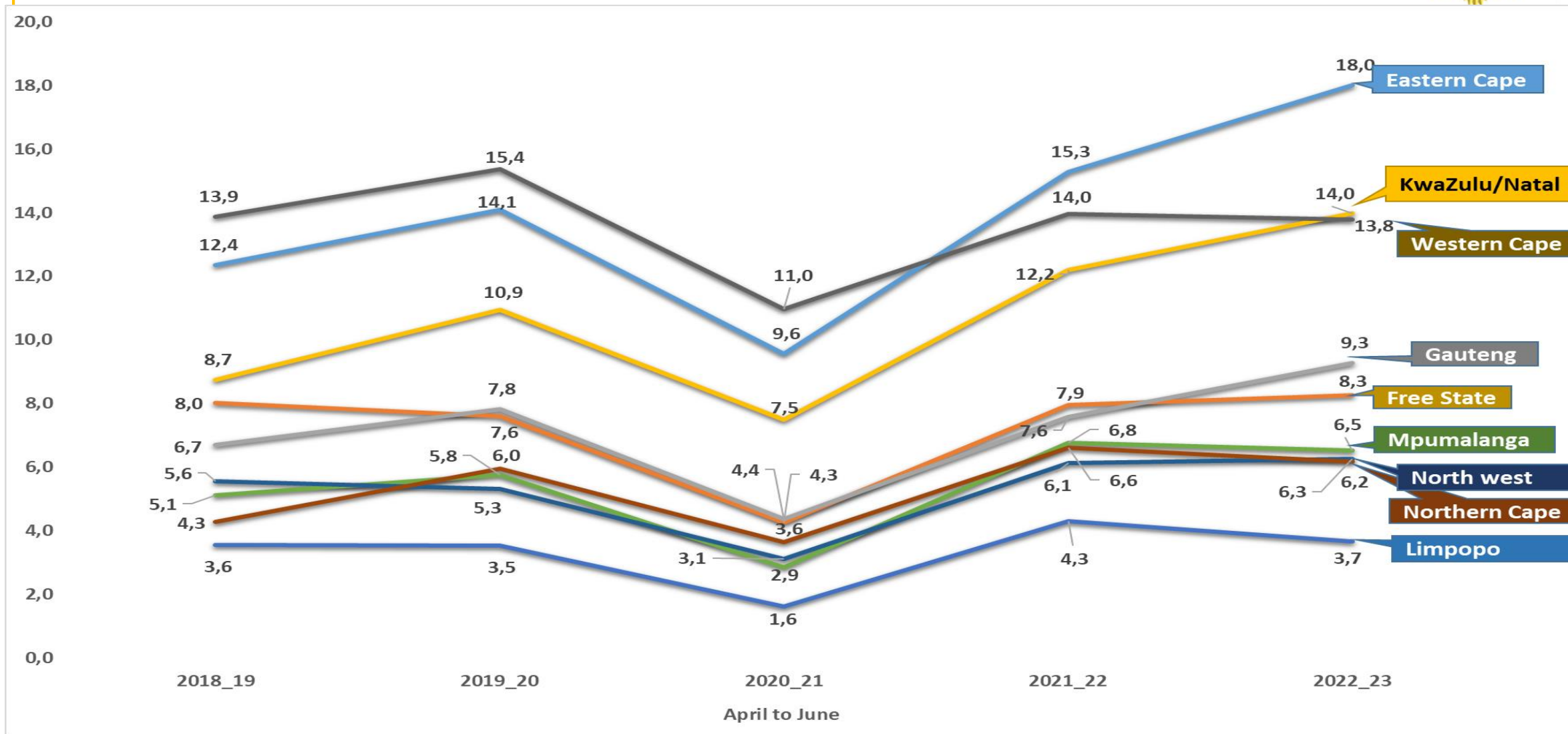

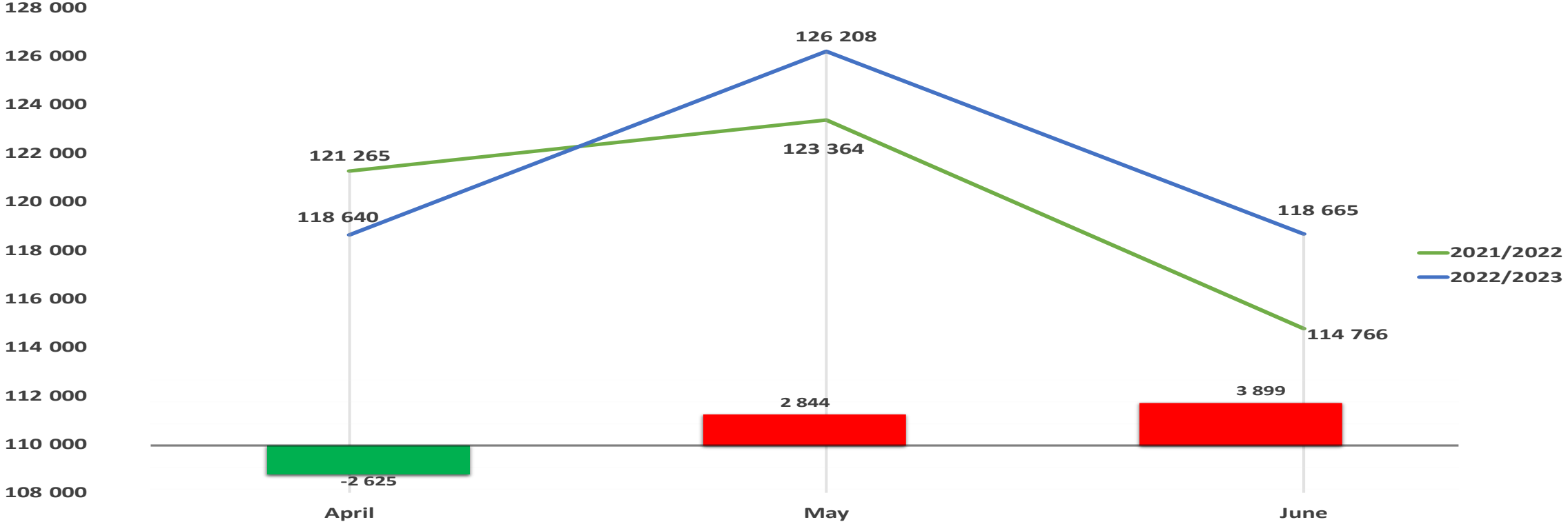

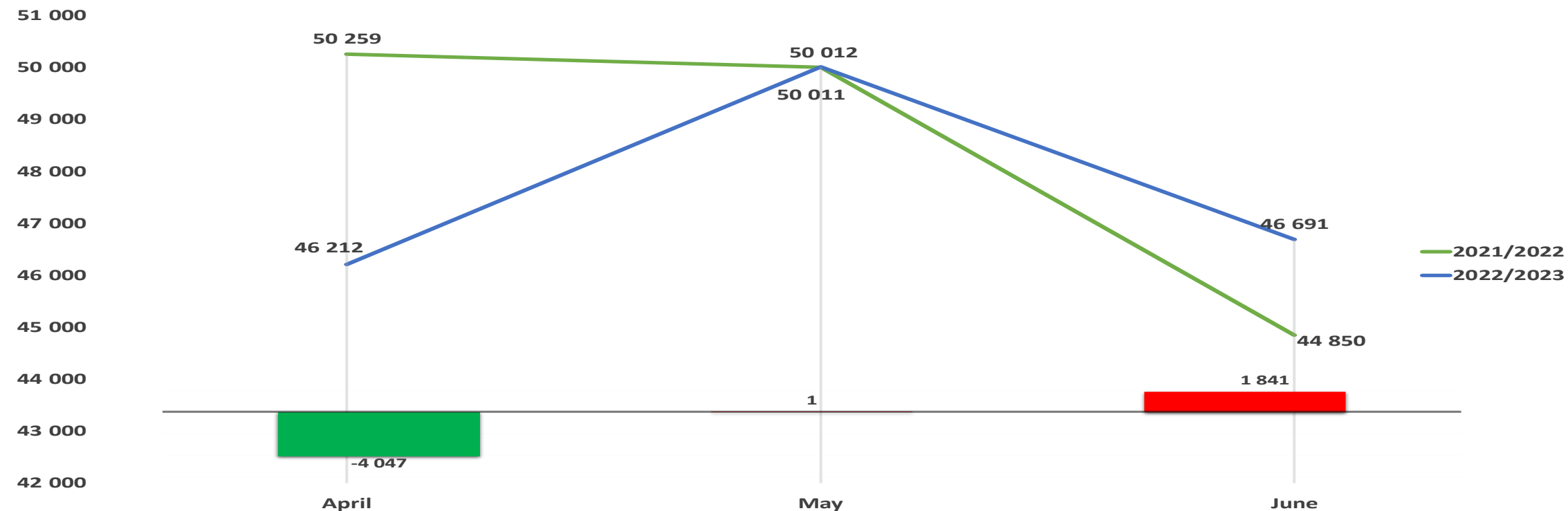

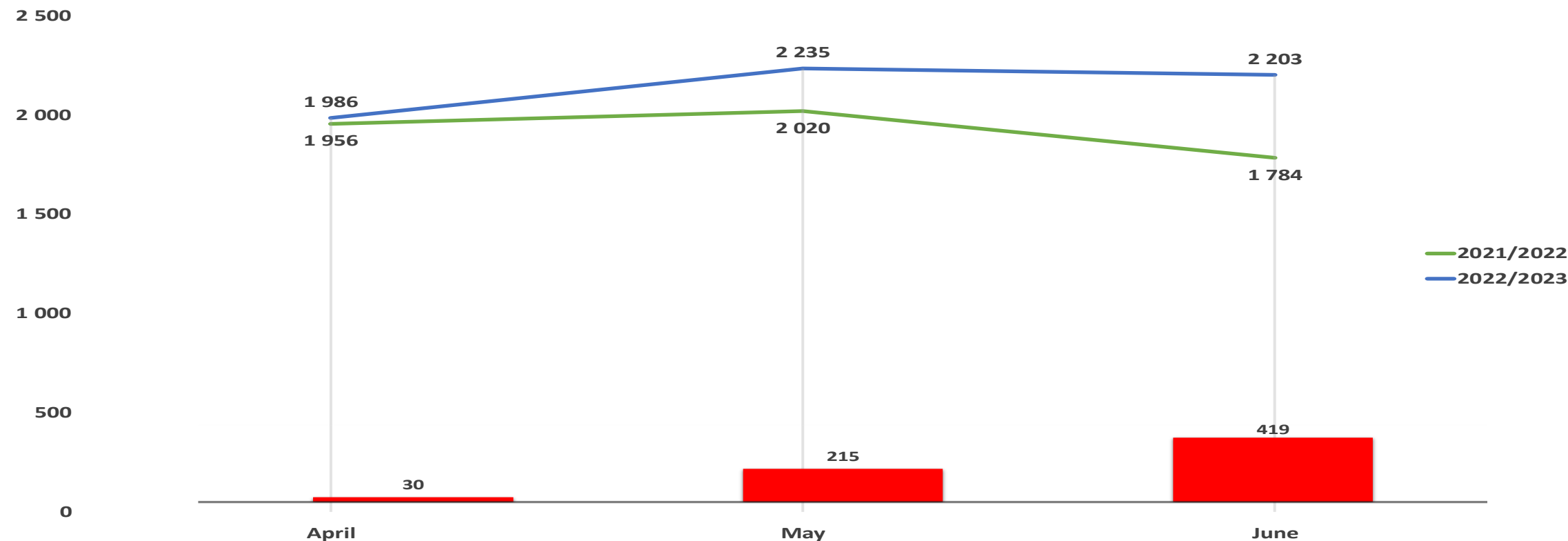

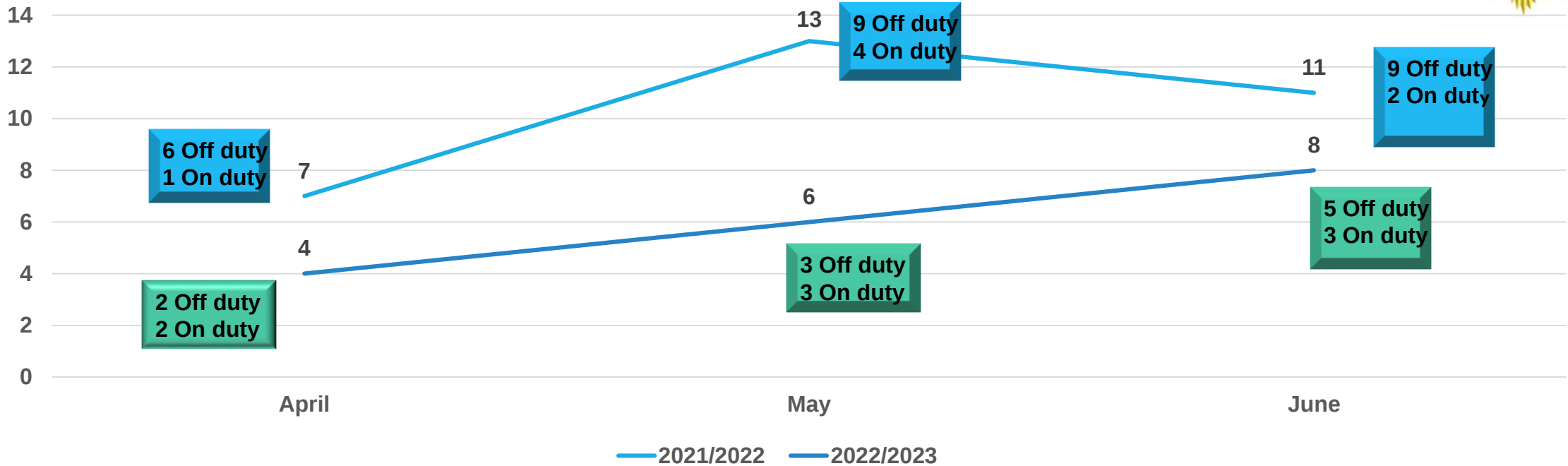

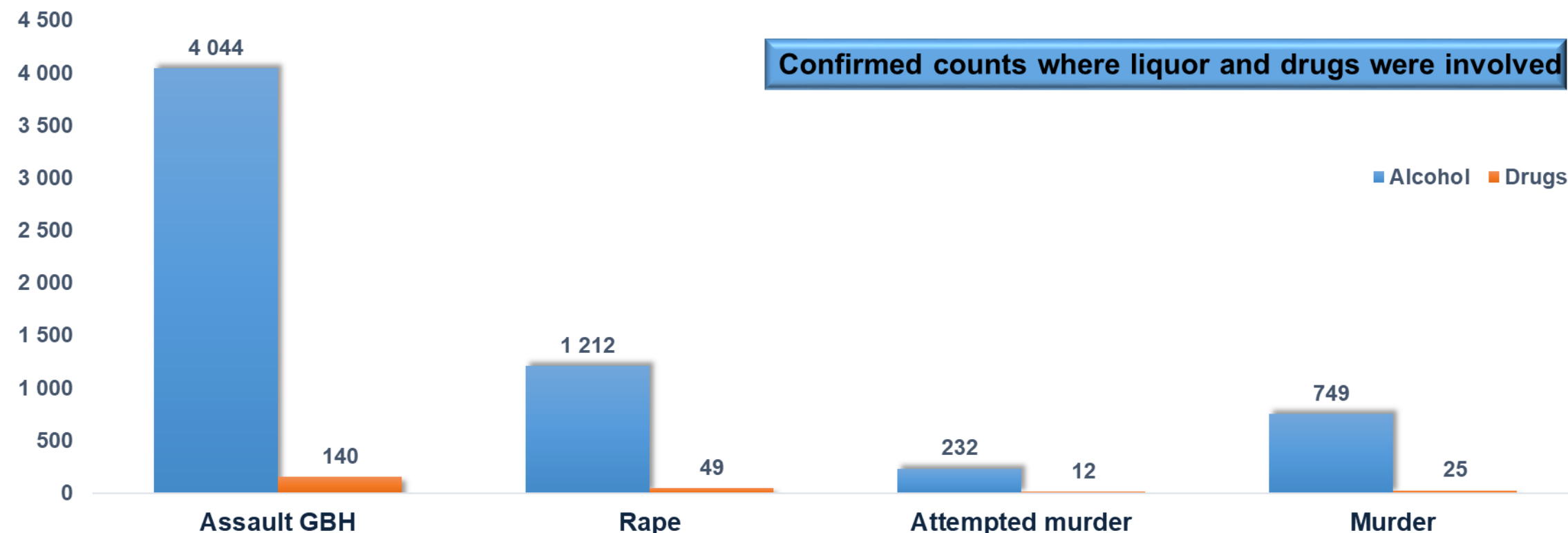


MURDER AND RAPE: EDUCATIONAL PREMISES 2022/2023(APRIL TO JUNE)

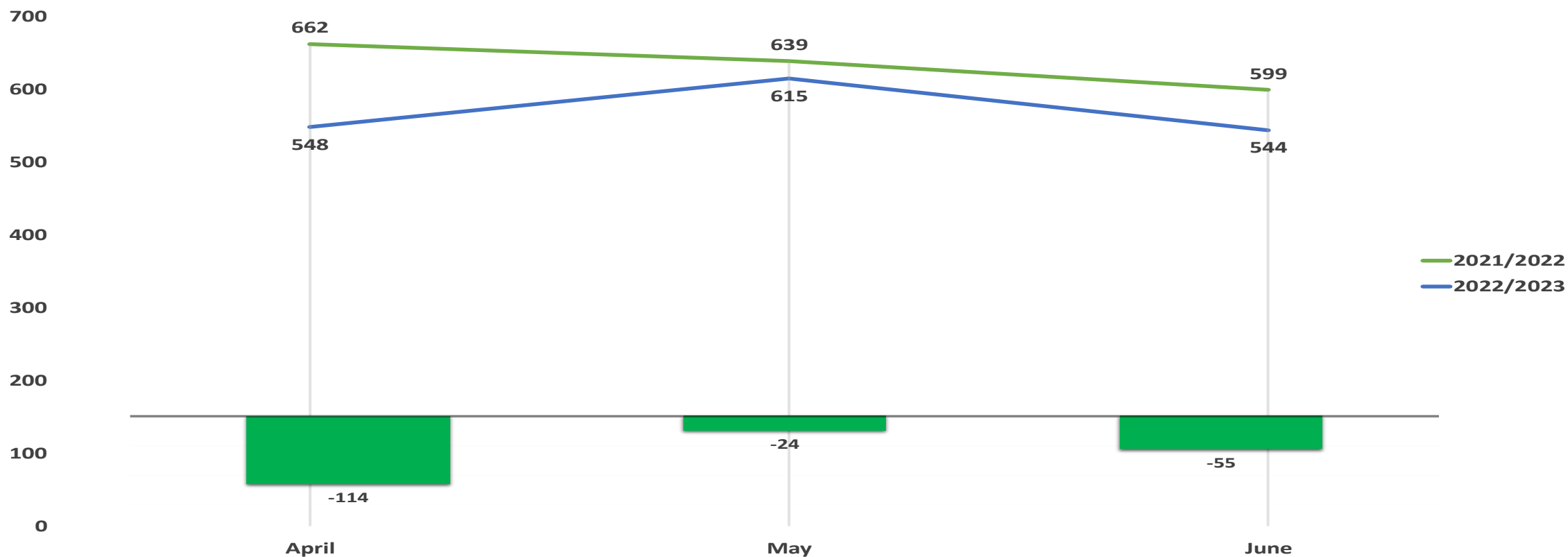

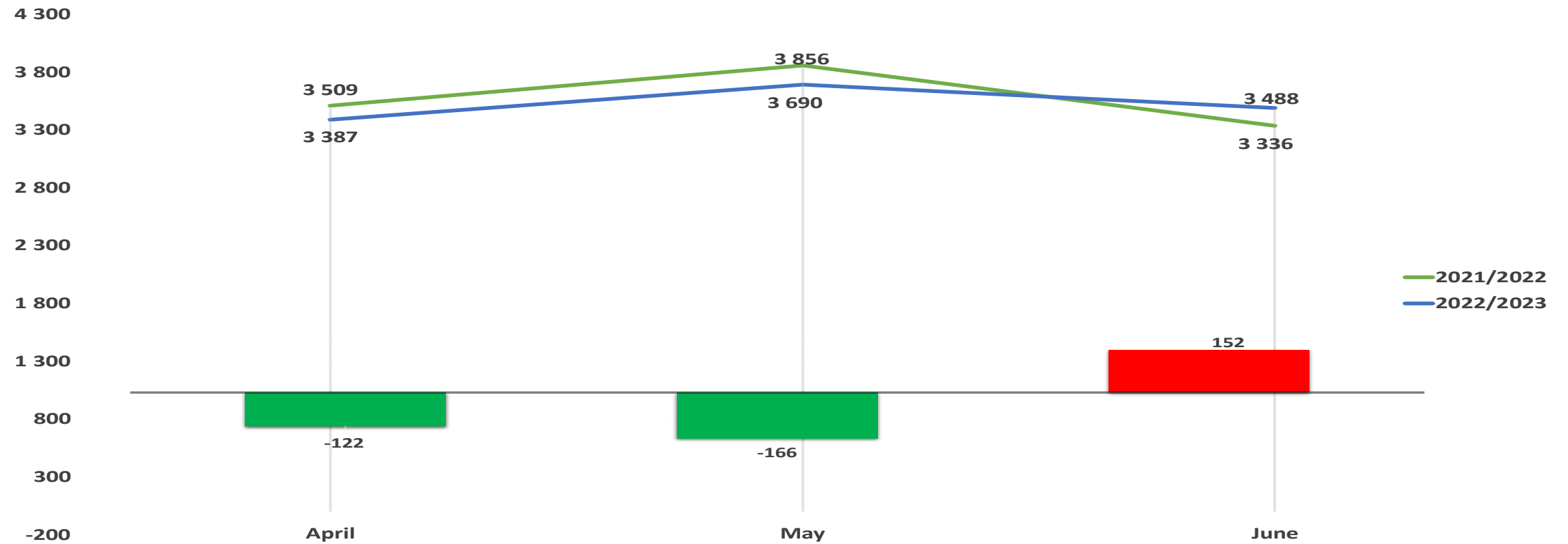

TYPE OF CIT APRIL TO JUNE 2022/2023



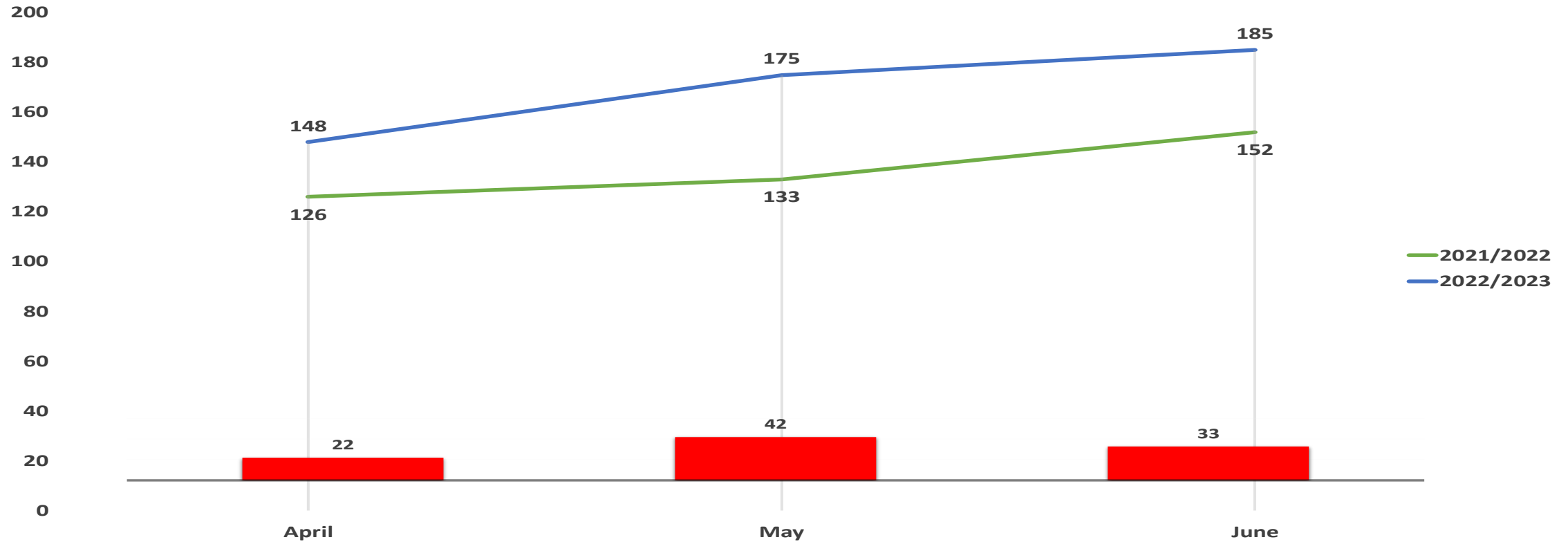

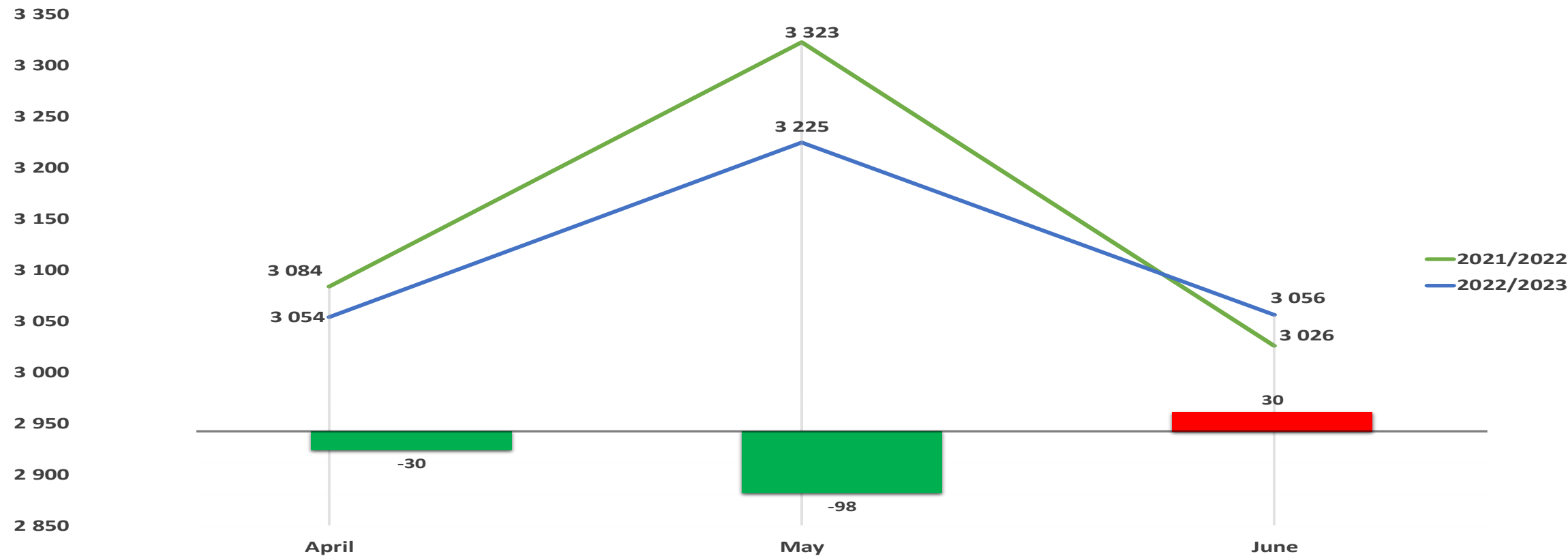

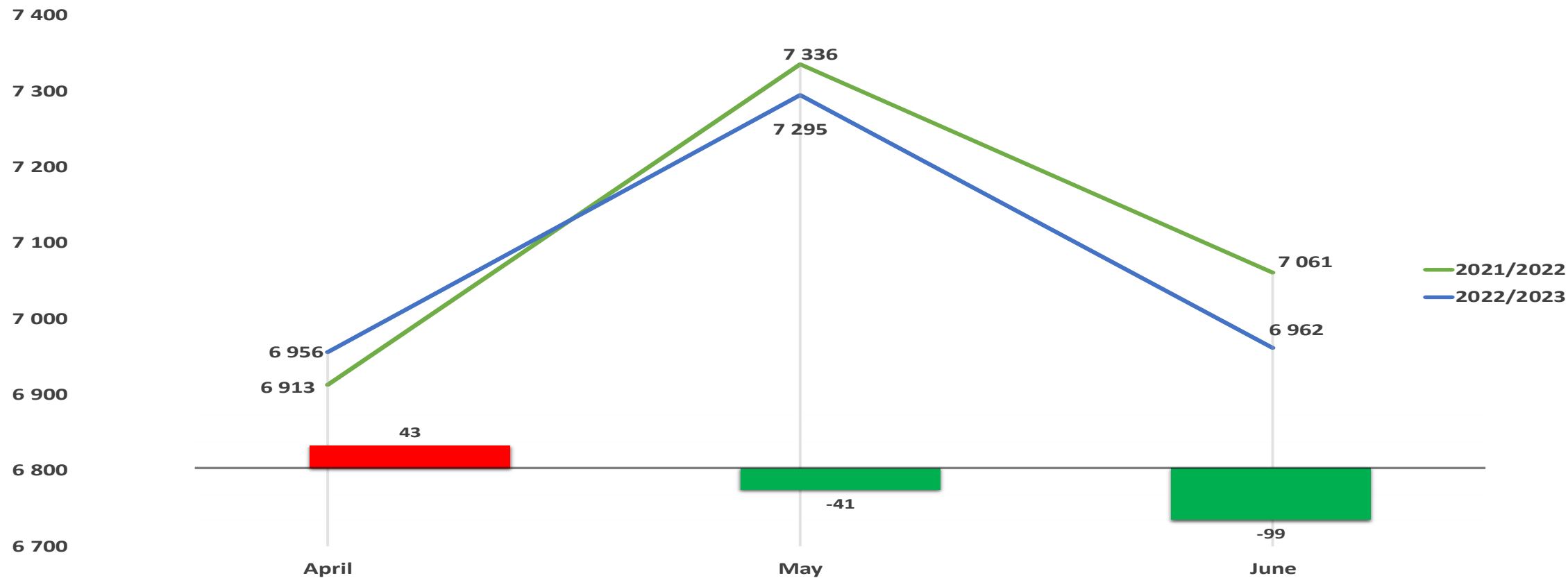

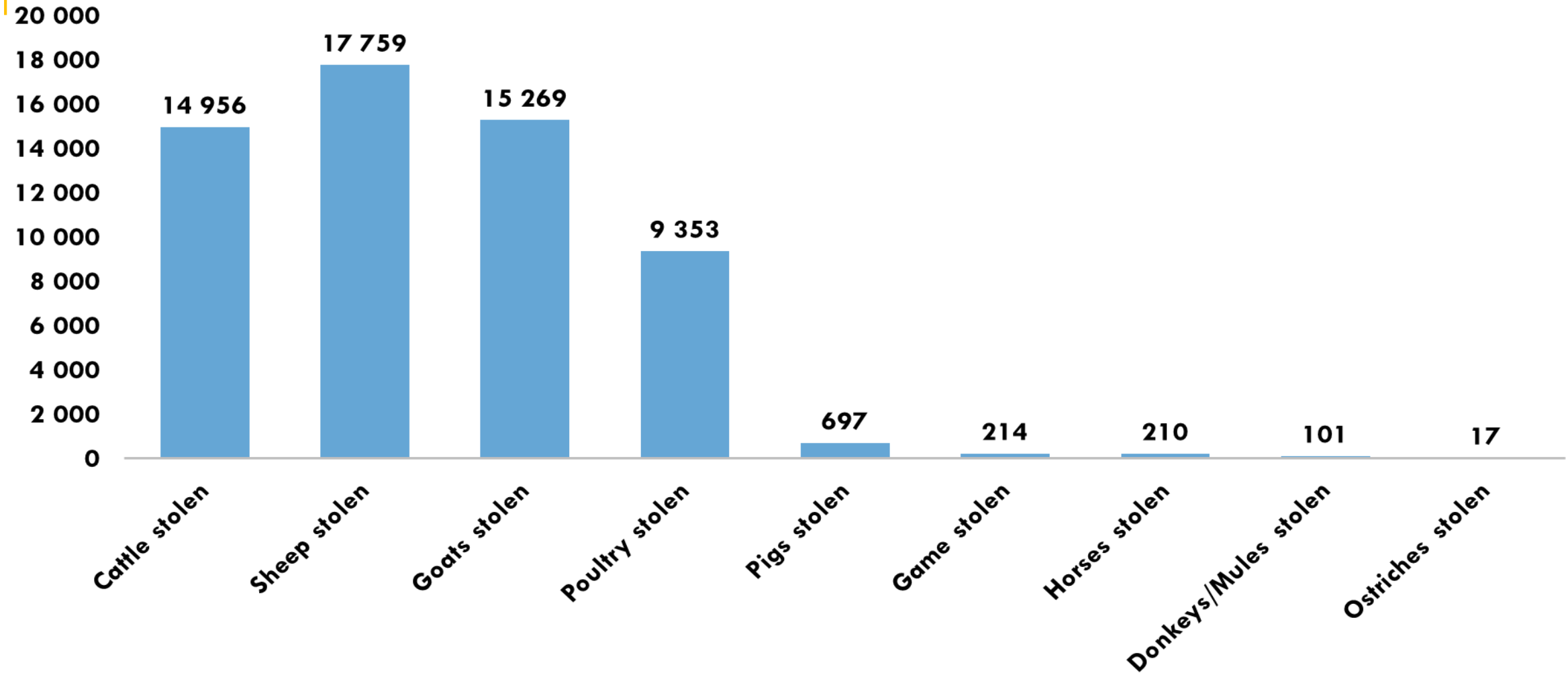

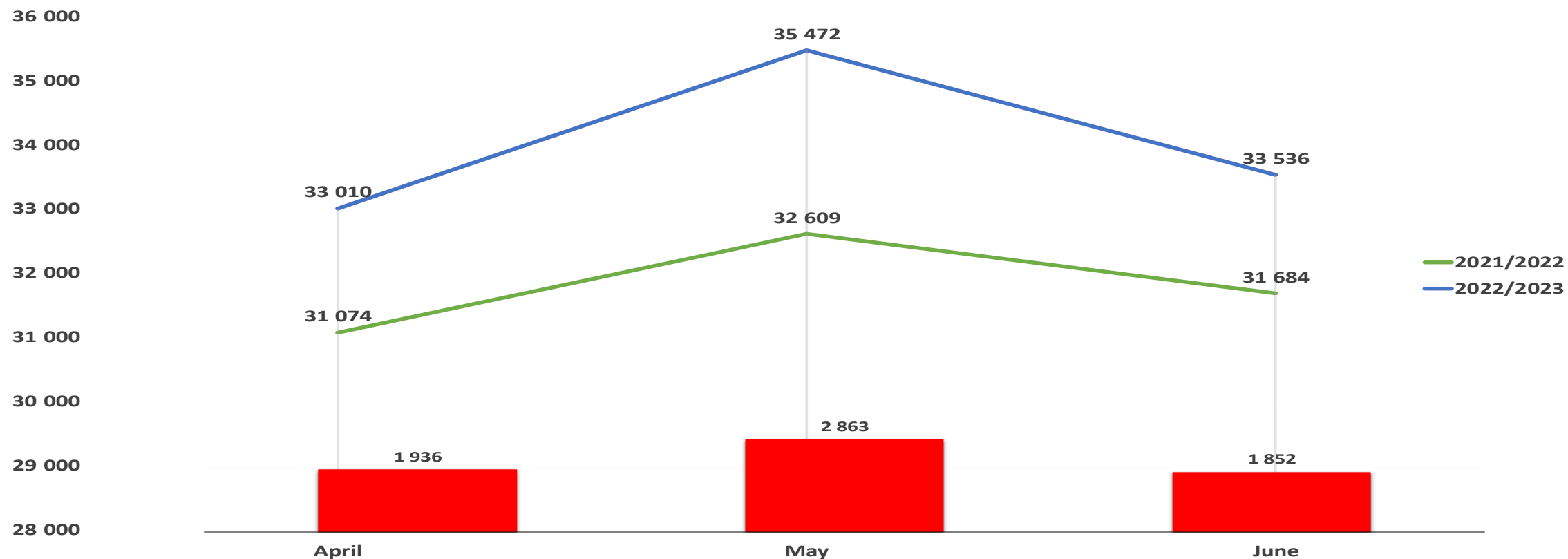


TYPE OF STOCK STOLEN

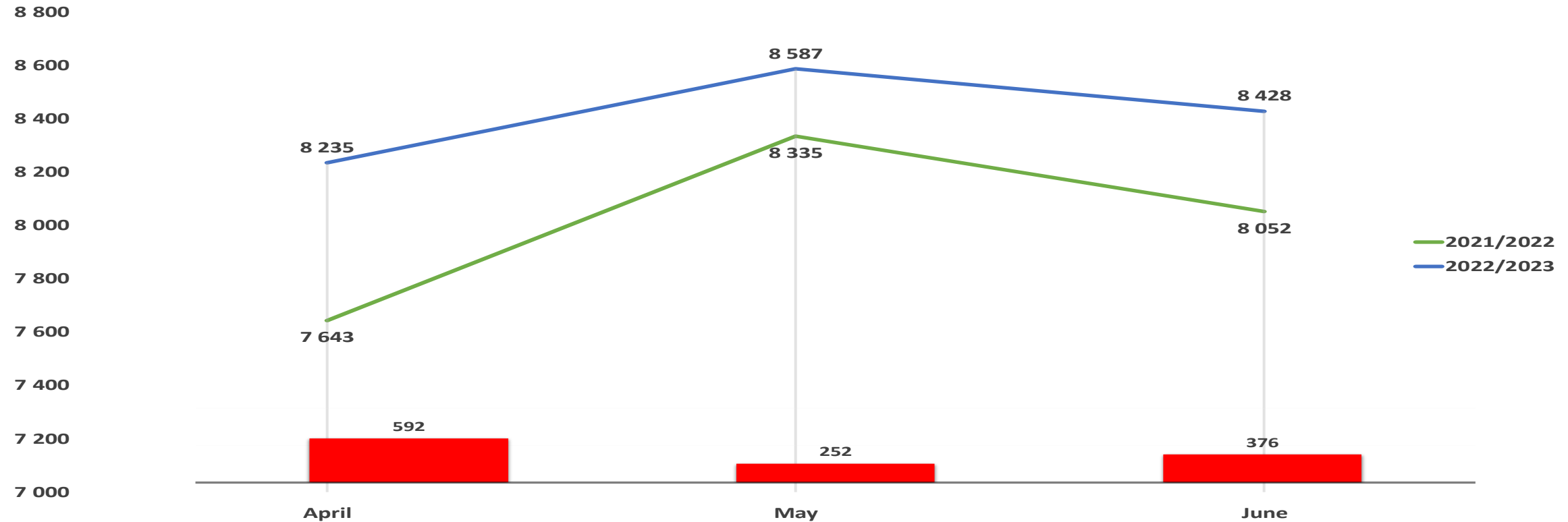

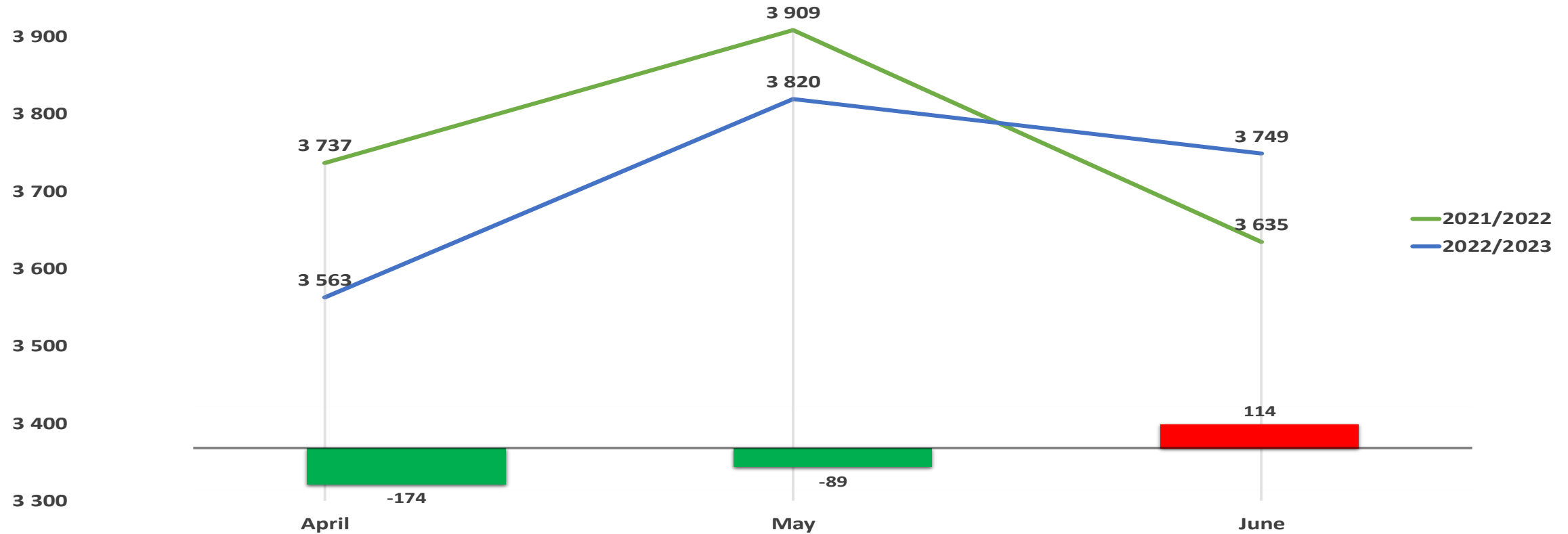

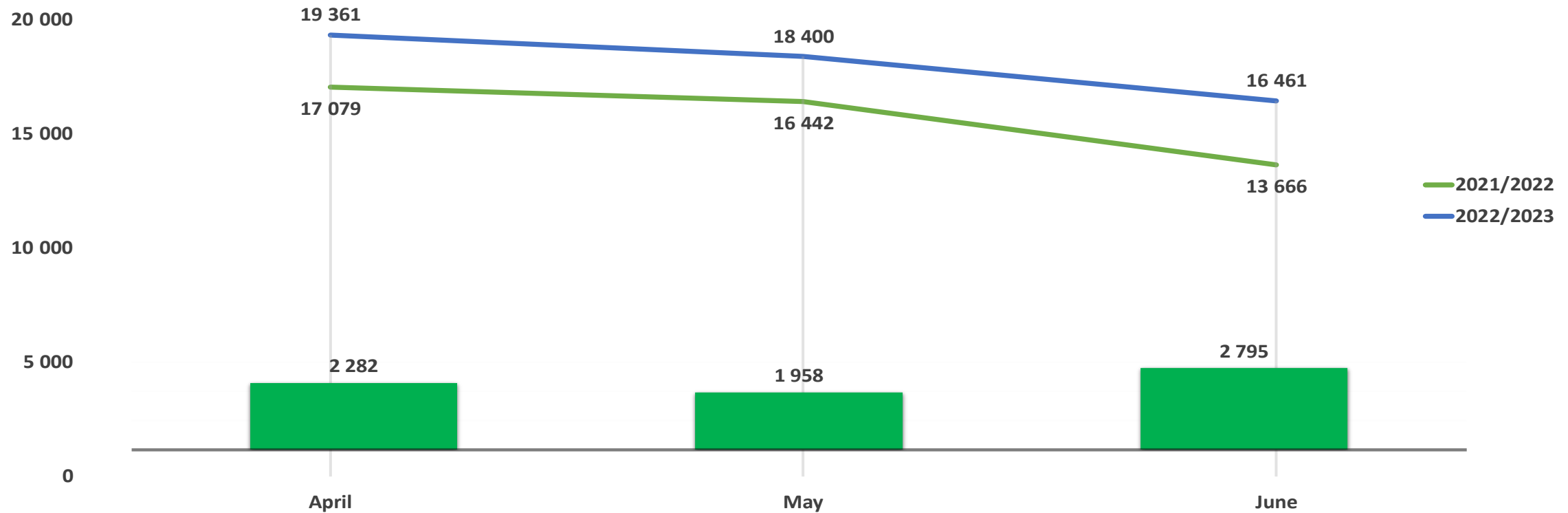

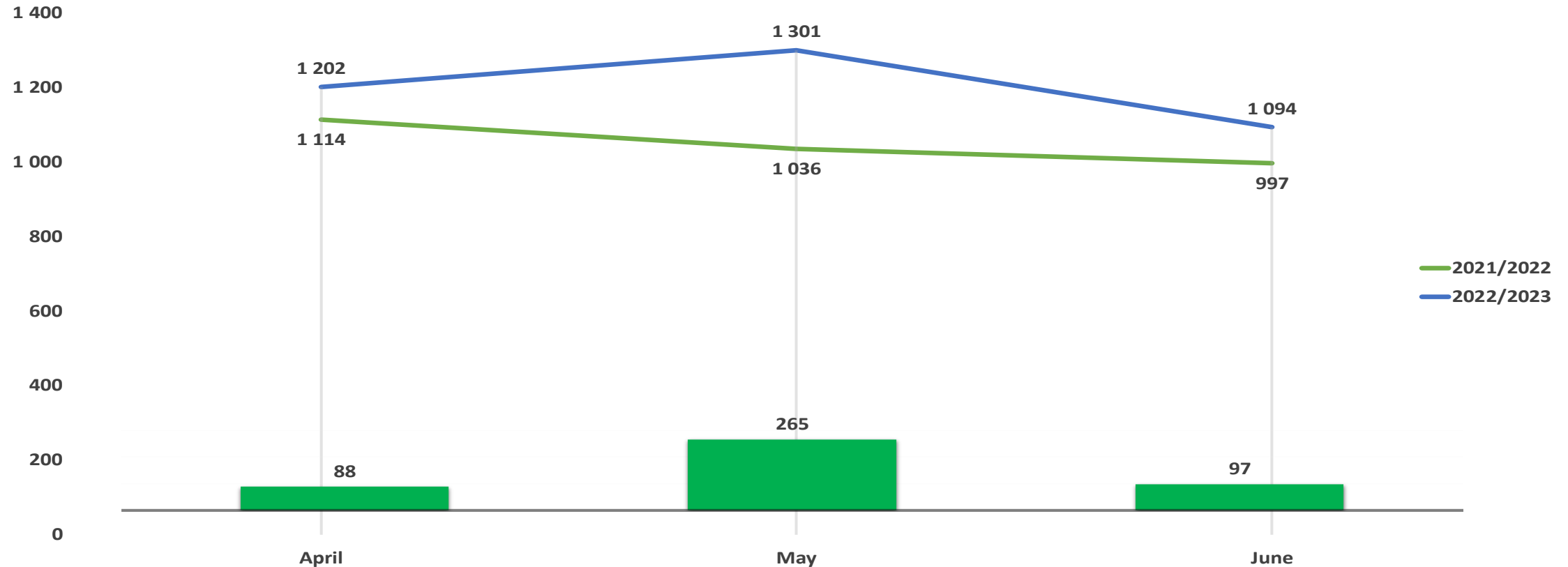

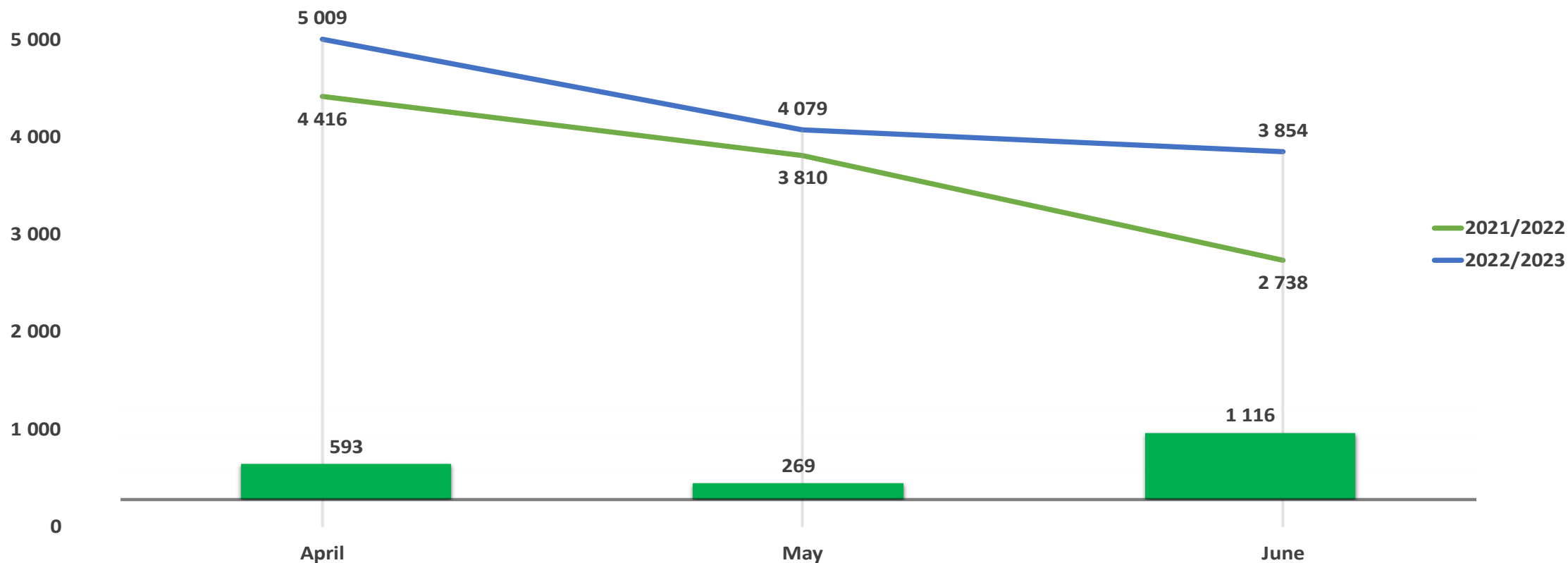

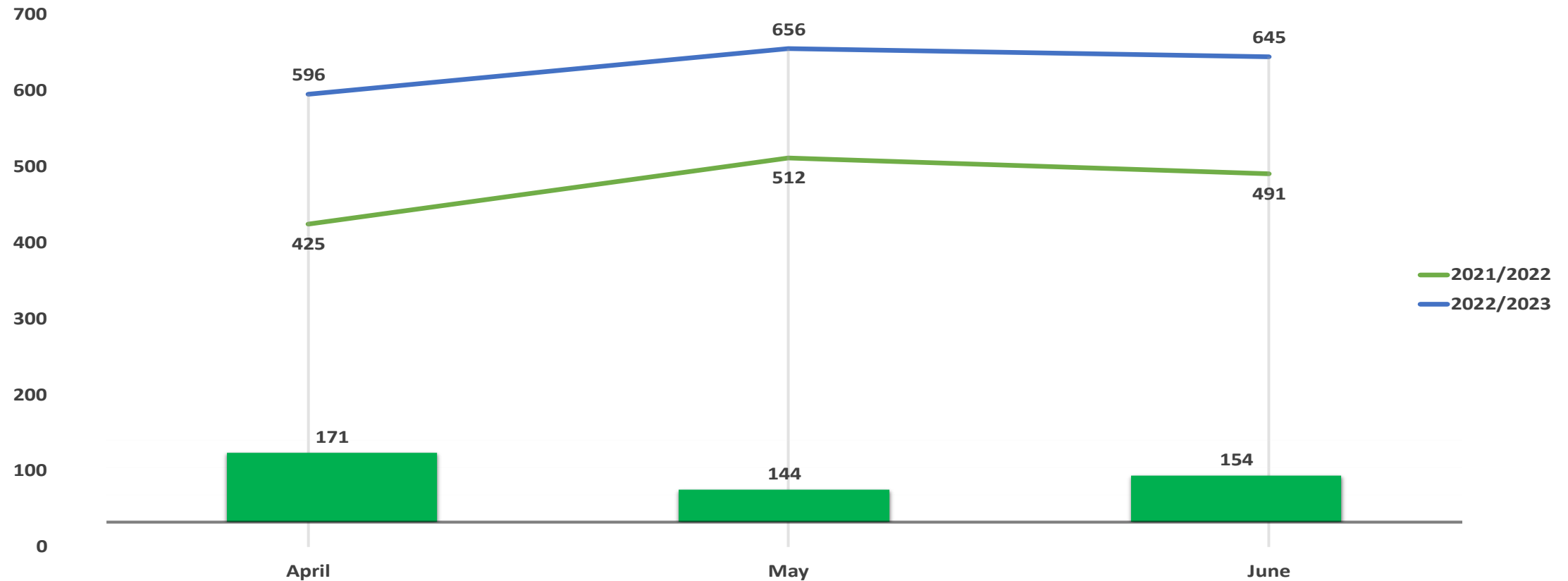
